



JAC and BlueGO to offer free bus service from Carson City to South Lake Tahoe November 23 – 29

Jump Around Carson (JAC), funded by the Carson City Regional Transportation Commission, and BlueGO have entered a two-year agreement to provide bus service between downtown Carson City and South Lake Tahoe using BlueGO buses.

The service, known as Route 21X – Spooner Express, will begin on November 23. Free rides will be offered on Route 21X Sunday, November 23, through Saturday, November 29.

SCHEDULE

Route 21X will depart the Carson City Downtown Transfer Center eight times a day, seven days a week, at 6:35 am, 7:35 am, 8:45 am, 9:45 am, 3:30 pm, 4:30 pm, 5:30 pm, and 6:30 pm.

BUS STOP LOCATIONS

JAC bus stops will be used for this service and will be marked with Route 21X. Bus stop locations in Carson City will be at the Downtown Transfer Center on Plaza Street, on Stewart Street near the Department of Motor Vehicles office, at Casino Fandango/Galaxy Theatres on Curry Street, at Fuji Park/Costco Wholesale on Old Clear Creek Road, and at the Park and Ride on Highway 50 at Highway 395.

FARES

General fare (age 5-59) one-way trip will be \$4.00, disabled persons and seniors (age 60 and over) one-way trip will be \$1.00. Transfers from JAC, Carson City's transit system, cost \$2.00 for general fare. Passes will be available on the bus. Check the website for updates to bus pass locations.
