



## Cost Containment Plan - Effective Wednesday, January 13, 2010

*Listed Below is a Supplement to the Rider's Guide Use This Information To Help You!*

STATA must save approximately **\$211,000** or **7,596** service hours to balance the operating budget for the remainder of this year. It is proposed that once funding is restored by the State of California and all grants have been reimbursed to STATA from its grantors by fiscal year 2010-2011, STATA intends to restore the suspended schedules from each of the routes listed below. **The cost containment plan will last for 169 days from Wednesday, January 13, 2010 until Wednesday, June 30, 2010.** It is anticipated that the schedules approved by STATA Board of Directors on August 28, 2009 will be restored on Thursday, July 1, 2010.

**There are no changes to Routes 20X, 21X, 23, 24X, 30, Gold Route 13, Purple Route 14, Black Route 17X and Violet Route 18X at this time. They are funded by secured grants which can only be used on these routes only.**
