Welcome to BlueGO, a service of the South Tahoe Area Transit Authority. BlueGO is a coordinated transit system consisting of fixed routes, curb to curb demand responsive services, Heavenly ski shuttles, commuter express routes and the Nifty 50 Trolley.

As soon as you park your car, your fun begins. The BlueGO Nifty 50 Trolley was created in 1994 to provide folks access to the entire south and west shore of Lake Tahoe access without the need of a car to enjoy the area's many recreational opportunities. Now you can think of the south Tahoe area as one big attraction! From secluded hideaways to lake cruises to beautiful beaches, the Trolley will get you there and back every 60 minutes. You'll enjoy a fun and informative narration from each trolley operator who shares some history, some humor and some useful information about the Lake Tahoe area. With your camera, make sure you take a snapshot of you in front of the beautiful trolleys for one more delightful memory of your visit.

Connections are possible to BlueGO Camp Richardson Circulator for every Saturday and Sunday, from Memorial Day to Labor Day between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. for service to destinations in the Camp Richardson area between Pope Beach and Baldwin Beach. Vintage cars meet the trolleys at :00 and :30 past the hour.

Hours & Days of Operation

BlueGO Nifty 50 Trolley operates daily from Saturday, May 23, 2009 to Monday, September 7, 2009 and every Saturday and Sunday from Saturday, September 12, 2009 to Sunday, October 4, 2009. Service hours on Route 30 between 9:15 a.m. and 7:15 p.m. every 60 minutes.

Trolleys will also be added on Route 50 between Kingsbury Transit Center and South Y Transit Station as well as Neighborhood Shuttles Routes 22, 53 and 55, seven days a week.

Fares

BlueGO Nifty 50 Trolley accepts Day Passes and Monthly Passes from TART in Tahoma or the South Shore Water Shuttle at Camp Richardson Resort. An additional fare is required to transfer to other BlueGO routes.

Day GOPasses are valid on all BlueGO fixed route bus routes. An upgrade is required to ride BlueGO OnCall or express routes.

BlueGO accepts Monthly GOPasses, tokens and 10-Ride & 20-Ride Express GOPasses for no additional fare.

Other Important Information

If you lose an item on a Nifty 50 Trolley vehicle, please call (530) 541-7149. BlueGO or its contractor, are not responsible for lost or stolen items on board vehicles.

Rules ensure safety and comfort for all passengers and the trolley operator. Please observe the following rules:

- No smoking on trolleys or at transit facilities.
- Eating & drinking is permitted provided that you dispose waste from eating or drinking.
- No standing in front of the yellow "standee" line, while the trolley is in motion.
- No abusive, threatening or obscene language.
- All electronic devices in use require the use of headphones.
- No hazardous materials or weapons of kind shall be allowed on board (except oxygen).
- All animals brought on board must be in a approved pet carrier, except properly documented service animals.
- No vandalism or graffiti allowed on trolleys.
- No illegal activity of any kind shall be tolerated.
- All strollers, scooters, folding carts and large packages must be stowed away under the seat.
- Rollerblades & skates are not allowed.
- Shoes and shirts are required to ride trolleys.
- No littering on trolleys or at transit facilities.

The above rules are enforced under the California Penal Code Section 640. Violation of the rules may result in suspension of ride, a \$250 fine and/or 6 months of community service.

Seniors and Persons with Disabilities Service

All BlueGO vehicles are fully equipped with wheelchair lifts* & securement area with space for up to two wheelchairs. The trolley operator will provide assistance. Any other additional assistance will require the use of a personal care attendant (PCA). A PCA can accompany a person with disability at no additional charge. Trolley operators are required to secure all wheelchairs before leaving the trolley stop.

Special Needs Pass can be obtained by calling the El Dorado County Department of Human Services at (530) 573-3490.

**Wheelchair means a 3 or 4 wheeled mobility aid that does not exceed 30 inches in width and 48 inches in length and does not weigh more than 600 pounds when occupied.*

Riding BlueGO Nifty 50 Trolley & Schedules

Trolleys generally operate every 60 minutes between South Y Transit Station and Tahoma. Times are approximate and may vary due to traffic and weather conditions. Schedules are subject to change without notice. Please plan accordingly. You may call (530) 541-7149 (TDD/TTY: 711) to check on the status of the location of trolley vehicles. Connection times to TART is possible by asking the trolley operator.

BlueGO only stops at trolley and/or bus stops with a BlueGO or Trolley Stop sign. Flag stops are not permitted. When the trolley approaches, stand near the BlueGO sign and make sure that the trolley operator can see you. Some stops are served by more than one bus and or trolley route, check the windshield or destination sign for information on the route serving your trolley and/or bus stop. When you see the trolley nearing your destination or transfer point, signal the trolley operator that you want to get off by pulling the cord or asking the trolley operator. Please provide enough notice, so that the trolley operator can make a smooth stop. If you are not familiar with the area, ask the trolley operator for assistance.
